Summary

Rotondo Weirich was awarded both the Precast Modular Cell and Structural Precast Package for Phase 5 of the North Branch Correctional Facility in Cumberland, Maryland. Previously, RW completed the Modular Cell Package for Phase 3 of the facility construction. Working again with local precasters, RW coordinated erection of both the cells and structural precast. Erection began on September 15, 2006 and was completed on March 21, 2007. During the 132 working days of the erection schedule, a total of 2212 pre-cast pieces were erected to the new facility addition. This included 256 cell modules, 624 wall panels and 1332 pieces of hollowcore. Working with a seasoned team of subcontractors, RW's production and delivery system succeeded in supplying the owner and contractor with superior and timely results.
